



The International Union of Notaries (UINL) and the Hague Conference on Private International Law (HCCH) are pleased to announce the 5th International Forum on the electronic Apostille Pilot Program (e-APP) and Digital Authentication which will be held in London, United Kingdom on Saturday 13th June 2009, following the conclusion of the deliberations of the General Council of the UINL.

The First International Forum on e-Notarization and e-Apostilles was held in Las Vegas in 2005. Jointly organised by the HCCH and the UINL, and hosted by the National Notary Association of the United States of America (NNA), this very successful Forum led the foundation for the launch of the e-APP by the HCCH and the NNA in April 2006. The subsequent Fora held in 2006 (Washington), 2007 (Los Angeles) and 2008 (New Orleans) were all organised by the NNA (for more information on the e-APP, see the Apostille Section of the HCCH website at www.hcch.net and the e-APP website at www.e-APP.info).

This 5th International Forum on the e-APP & Digital Authentication is the first to be held in Europe, and is now once more organised by the UINL and the HCCH. The Forum will enable participants to share their experience and to learn from recent developments in the field of electronic authentication.

The proceedings are without cost to delegates, though space is limited, so registration will be required. Please send an e-mail to the organisers at <u>uinl@johnvenn.co.uk</u> to confirm your attendance.

The venue for the session, which will start at around 11.00 am, will be the Renaissance Chancery Court Hotel, 252 High Holborn, London WC1V 7EN, which is right in the centre of London, close to the British Museum. Simultaneous translation will be provided in English, French, German, Spanish and Italian.

Hotel accomodation can be booked through the agency for the UINL meeting, and a copy of the hotel booking form is attached.

In addition the hosts, the Society of Scrivener Notaries, are organising a formal Dinner on the evening of Friday, 12th June. The dinner, for which evening dress is required, will be a unique occasion to witness some of the the ancient ceremony attached to the livery companies. There will be a charge of £95 for this dinner.
