Yuko Nishitani

Since April 2011, Yuko Nishitani is a professor of private international law at Kyushu University in Fukuoka, Japan. Prior to joining the faculty in Kyushu, she was an associate professor at Tohoku University in Sendai, Japan from 1997 till 2007. During the Spring Semester 2012, she is visiting Duke University in the U.S.

Graduate of Kyoto University in Japan, she did a Ph.D. at Heidelberg University in Germany (2008). After starting her career as an academic, she did research during sabbatical years in Italy (1999/2000), the U.S. (2003/04), France (2007/08) and Germany (2009/11). She was a visiting faculty at Brescia University in Italy (2007 and 2008) and Duke University in the U.S. (2009). In 2004, she served as a Legal Officer on Secondment at the Permanent Bureau of the Hague Conference on Private International Law. She was appointed Director of Studies (English) (2004) and Lecturer (2011) at the Hague Academy of International Law. Her main research interests consist in conflict of laws, international civil litigation, comparative law and family law.
