

**Answers to the Questionnaire accompanying the new practical handbook of
the Hague Convention of 18 November 1970 on the Taking of Evidence
Abroad in Civil or Commercial Matters**

- 2. – Ukraine hasn't received requests from States Parties under this Convention.
- 3. – No, we haven't encountered practical difficulties, because Ukraine hasn't received the requests under the Hague Convention of the 18 November 1970 on the taking of evidence abroad in civil or commercial matters.
- 10. – No, Ukrainian Central Authority does not receive requests by electronic means to obtain evidence from abroad.
- 11. – No, Ukrainian Central Authority has not received or forwarded requests to obtain evidence requiring the use of new information technology.

Judicial requests under Evidence Convention, 1970, ought to be drawn up by judicial bodies of Ukraine (courts).
